### **APPLICATION DEADLINES:**

Spring applicants must submit completed applications by December 1<sup>st</sup>.  
Fall applicants must submit completed applications by August 1<sup>st</sup>.

### **ACCEPTANCE PROCEDURE:**

After initial acceptance into the program, and for final acceptance, you must:

1. Attend orientation as scheduled by the PCT Department
2. Provide TB skin test results (Must be current for the entire program).
3. Provide proof of current Flu Vaccine.
4. Submit to a urine drug screen which will be administered by the school.
5. Pass a background check satisfactory to clinical partners requirements and Office of Long Term Care.

**Random drug screens may be requested for suspicion at any time during the course of the program at the student's expense.**
