2016-2017 Not Required to Register for Selective

To be eligible for federal student financial aid, males (any person assigned the sex of male at birth) aged 18 – 25 are required to register with the Selective Service System (SS). This requirement covers males residing in the United States who are U. S. citizens.

If you are *not required* to register for the Selective Service, place an “X” in the next to the statement that best describes your situation.

_____ I am currently in the armed services and on active duty (this exception does not apply to members of the Reserve National Guard who are not on active duty);

_____ I am not yet 18 at the time I completed the FAFSA (an update is not required during the year, even if I return 18 After completing the FAFSA);

_____ I am a citizen of the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands, or the Federated States of Micronesia;

_____ I am a noncitizen who first entered the U.S. after I turned 26;

_____ I am a noncitizen who entered the U.S. as a lawful *nonimmigrant* on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. on the Terms of that visa until after I turned 26;

_____ I am a transgender male who assigned the sex of female at birth.
