**Background:** The James and Joan Tinsley Scholarship is a \$500.00 renewable scholarship to be awarded to an Arkansas State University-Newport student. The scholarship is designed to provide aid to students who demonstrate financial need. These funds can be applied toward tuition, fees, and/or books.

## **Application Requirements:**

- The applicant must have a minimum cumulative high school or college GPA of 2.50.
- The applicant must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours.
- The applicant must possess a positive attitude, strong work ethic and recognizable drive.
- Significant preference will be given to residents of Swifton, AR.
- The applicant must write an essay (200-250 words). SEE BELOW.

Award Amount: \$500.00 per semester

### **Renewal Requirements:**

• Students must have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA) and pass 67% of their courses (PACE). The scholarship may be renewable for up to three additional semesters if the required GPA and PACE are met. Academic Progress will be verified at the end of each term of enrollment by the ASUN Financial Aid office.

#### Other Information:

 Selections will be made by a scholarship committee consisting of the Dean of Enrollment, Dean of Community Engagement and Advancement Officer. The donor will reserve the right to select recipient if they so choose.
