Articulation Agreement

Arkansas Rural Nursing Education Consortium (ARNEC)

AND

Henderson State University (HSU)

For Associate of Arts/Science

This formal articulation agreement is made and entered into by Henderson State University, hereinafter referred to as HSU, and Arkansas Rural Nursing Education Consortium, hereinafter referred to as ARNEC, which is a consortium of the following schools: ASU-Newport, Black River Technical College, Cossatot Community College, Ozarka College, South Arkansas Community College, U of A Hope/Texarkana, U of A Morrilton, and U of A Rich Mountain. By entering into this agreement, ARNEC and HSU express our mutual commitment to serve students in Arkansas by providing high quality educational programs and services. This agreement provides information for transfer of the general transfer degree program.

Purpose

These two institutions seek to assist students in making a seamless transfer from the associate degree to the baccalaureate degree by clarifying transfer policies and procedures between programs. Both institutions recognize the value and benefit of the completion of the AA/AS degree as the first two years of a baccalaureate degree prior to transfer. Participation in this agreement requires commitment on the part of the student and both institutions involved.

HSU will apply such to the Bachelor of Science degree in a manner consistent with the treatment of native students.

For ARNEC students entering focused programs, HSU will credit designated ARNEC courses as defined in an addendum to this agreement.

Condition of Transfer

Section I: Admissions and Matriculation

ARNEC students maintaining continuous enrollment under this agreement will be afforded the same treatment and protections as HSU native students enrolled under a specific catalog. Criteria for acceptance into HSU will be the same for transfer as for native students.

Upon request of students, ARNEC will provide verification of completed course to HSU, through its (Admissions/Registration) office.

Transfer students from ARNEC will have access to financial aid, advising and other student services on the same basis as native students.

HSU will apply the same academic progress and graduation standards to students who transferred from ARNEC as those applied to native students.

ARNEC and HSU will cooperatively develop, regularly review, and update advisement materials. This will enable students to meet the terms of this agreement and transfer to HSU with maximum ease.

ARNEC will advise interested students on the availability of the articulation agreement and the opportunities available to them by participating.

ARNEC and HSU will publicize the existence of the articulation agreement. Use of either institution's name and/or log in mass marketing materials requires mutual agreement negotiated between both marketing departments.

Section II: Transfer Credit

The HSU RN-BSN Completion Track Plan grants 38 nursing credits for the progressing RN who graduated from an ACEN or NLNAC-accredited associate degree or diploma program; or, Arkansas State Board Approved at the time of graduation. These 38 credits, plus the required 33 HSU nursing course credits, and 49 pre-requisite/general education credits provide the total of 120 hours required for graduation with the BSN from HSU.

HSU will accept courses that are equivalent in rigor and content to its current curriculum in which a D or higher is earned unless a higher grade is required by a specific program. Nursing courses must have been completed with a C or higher. Developmental courses will not be accepted in transfer.

Representatives from ARNEC and HSU will develop and annually review Transfer Guides that will provide information on programs and requirements. The Transfer Guides are a part of this agreement and provide degree opportunities covered by this agreement.

Section III: Program Plan

Focused program agreements will be incorporated as addenda to this agreement. Each will specify student degree course plan and credit transfer requirements. Such addenda will be effective when signed by the Chief Academic Officer of each institution.

Terms of Agreement

This agreement is made and entered into the academic year 2018-2019 and remains in effect here forth. Both institutions hereby indicated full agreement to the terms and conditions included above and the honoring of the course, program and other requirements outlined in the Transfer Guides attached as appendices to this agreement. The agreement may be amended at any time with approval of both institutions and is subject to review every five years to assure currency with the respective degree requirements. Should either institution desire to discontinue this agreement, advance notifications of two years (24 months) will be required.

Arkansas Rural Nursing Education Consortium (ARNEC) and Henderson State University (HSU) hereby enter into this articulation agreement leading from the Associate in Arts/Science to the Bachelor of Science by the affixing of signatures of the Chief Executive officers of representative, of both institutions.
