ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- Directed electives depend upon the grade level a student will be teaching. See Advisor for specific pathway
- Students must take the Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators Exam
- To be accepted into a teacher education program at a university, students must attain a minimum overall GPA of 2.70
- Students must also complete the following specific courses with a grade of "C" or better in each. (ENG 1003, ENG 1013, MATH 1023, EDU 2023, and SPCH 1203)
- Admittance into the teacher education program at a university requires passing scores on the CORE Academic Skills for Educators Exams OR qualifying ACT scores. Those scores are Reading 156, Math 150, and Writing 162. If a student has a composite score of 24 and a 22 or above in reading, then the student is exempt from the reading portion of Praxis. If a student has a composite score of 24 and a 22 or above in math, then the student is exempt from the math portion of Praxis. If a student has a composite score of 24 and a 22 in writing, then the student is exempt from the writing portion of Praxis
- A felony conviction disqualifies one from gaining teacher licensure in Arkansas

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
