State Cosmetology Licensing Exam Qualifications

In order to qualify for the State Aesthetic Licensing Exam, a student must meet allthree of the following criteria:

- Complete the 16 credit hour Certificate of Proficiency in Aesthetics
- Accrue a minimum of at least 600 classroom/lab hours (requirement of the Arkansas State Board of Cosmetology)
- Receive program instructor recommendation
