



## Associates of Applied Science in Nursing Traditional Pathway (73 ch)

**Program Description:** The ASUN Associate Degree Nursing Program prepares students to take the profession nursing licensure exam (NCLEX-RN) upon successful completion of the classroom and clinical coursework. Curriculum is based on a 2-year (four semester) plan for full time students, who have completed all general education pre-requisite and corequisite courses. Students requiring developmental coursework may not be able to complete this program of study in six (6) semesters. Developmental courses do not count toward total degree hours. Students having completed college level courses prior to enrollment will be assisted by their advisor in making appropriate substitutions. General education courses may be interchanged between semesters.
