Application Requirements

- A minimum placement test score of 83 on the Compass Reading exam or equivalent (ACT- 19 Reading, ACCUPLACER- 80 Reading) is required for admission into the Aesthetic program
- Students must submit an application to ASUN and an application to the Aesthetic program
- Official transcripts (High School or Previous College/Universities Attended)

State Cosmetology Licensing Exam Qualifications

In order to qualify for the State Aesthetic Licensing Exam, a student must meet all three of the following criteria:

- Complete the 16 credit hour Certificate of Proficiency in Aesthetics
- Accrue a minimum of at least 600 classroom/lab hours (requirement of the Arkansas State Board of Cosmetology)
- Receive program instructor recommendation
