Background: The Arkansas State University-Newport Student GED[®] Scholarship is an institutional scholarship was created to promote college-going of GED graduates from the ASU-Newport Adult Education program.

Application Requirements:

- Earned GED Diploma from the ASU-Newport Adult Education Program.
- Not receiving any other ASU-Newport institutional scholarship.
- Application must be made prior to the deadline listed below.
- Scholarship can be applied to any academic program offered any of the ASU-Newport campuses
- Applicants must complete the current year's FAFSA. (ASUN School Code: 042034)

Award Amount: Award amount \$500 per semester. Renewable for three additional semesters or the length of the program.

Renewal Requirements:

- Students must have a 3.00 cumulative grade point average (GPA) and pass 67% of their courses (PACE). The scholarship is renewable for three additional semesters as long as the academic performances are met. Academic progress will be verified at the end of each term of enrollment by the ASUN financial aid office.
- Scholarship recipient must complete at least 12 hours per semester.

Other Information:

- Scholarships are awarded in the order they are received.
- All scholarship awards are contingent on availability of funds.
- A copy of student's Arkansas High School Diploma and GED® Score Report must be returned with application.
