



Arkansas State University-Newport The Marilyn Thompson Opportunity Through Education Scholarship Application

Background: The Marilyn Thompson Opportunity Through Education Scholarship is a renewable scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 per semester, to be awarded to an Arkansas State University-Newport student for up to four (4) semesters. The scholarship is designed to provide aid to students from a minority race or ethnicity who demonstrate financial need.

Application Requirements:

- The applicant must represent a minority race or ethnicity.
- Applicants seeking a degree in STEM and Business fields of study will receive preference.
- Applicants that have graduated from Newport High School will receive preference.
- Applicants planning to pursue a Bachelor or higher-level degree will receive preference.
- The applicant must write an essay (200-250 words). SEE BELOW.

Award Amount: \$500.00 per semester for up to four (4) semesters.

Renewal Requirements:

 Students must have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA) and pass 67% of their courses (PACE). The scholarship is renewable for three additional semesters if the required GPA and PACE are met. Academic Progress will be verified at the end of each term of enrollment by the ASUN Financial Aid office.

Other Information:

 Selections will be made by a scholarship committee consisting of a representative from Student Affairs, a STEM faculty member, a Business faculty member and a representative from the Office of Institutional Advancement. The donor will reserve the right to select recipient if they so choose.
